DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS

COMPETITIVE ALLOCATION

The Willacy County Advisory Committee met on Wednesday June 3, 2009 at the Raymondville City Hall at 9:00 AM. The Competitive Allocation is \$2,337,500 available for Hurricane Dolly related projects.

The Committee listened to four entities present their projects. Each presented project was scored individually and all the projects totaled \$2,578,276.

Upon completion of the presentations the difference between the presented projects and the funds available was only \$240,776 over the budget.

After discussion the representatives of the communities decided to reduce their projects respectively to the budget available. The discussion lead to a motion and passed unanimously to reduce their respective projects to fit the budget. The motion also allowed the City of San Perlita to maintain their budget for the Sewer Lift station that was damaged by the Hurricane and could not cut back on the project budget.

Therefore, the Citizens Advisory Committee recommends to the Willacy County Commissioners Court that all the attached projects be funded for a total of \$2,337,500.
